The Friends of Lake Forest Library inaugurated this scholarship in 2003 to recognize students whose lives are enriched by reading.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form
- Submit a 500-word essay
- Include a letter of recommendation from an adult who is not a relative
- Submit completed application to:
 - a) The College and Career Resource Center by March 15, 2022.
 - b) Drop off completed application to the LF Library by 5:00pm on March 15, 2022.
